PRINCIPAL INVESTIGATOR AND A CERTIFIED RAAB7 TRAINER TO CONDUCT A
RAAB7 SURVEY**

I. Presentation of the organisation

The Œuvre Médicale UEBC Grand Nord is a social work of Christian witness of the Union of Baptist Churches of Cameroon (UEBC) whose mission is to bring quality health care to all social strata at affordable cost, hence its slogan, the Gospel for all Man. It includes health facilities such as the Esther Binder Eye Centre in Mokong (COEBM).

Access to quality eye health services is a challenge for all communities, particularly for people living in developing countries, and more specifically in rural areas where eye health services are virtually non-existent. This situation is even more alarming for people with disabilities.

II. Objectives and description of the mission

The aim of this mission is to carry out a standardised RAAB7 survey using the framework of the national health system to assess the prevalence and causes of visual impairment and blindness in the Far North region, in order to collect evidence for the planning and implementation of comprehensive eye health programmes.

III. Profile of the Consultant

The consultant required must hold a master's or doctoral degree (PhD) in public health, ophthalmology or a related field. At least 5 years' experience in public health research, with specific expertise in conducting RAAB surveys or similar community-based evaluations.

IV. Consultation period and location

Consultations will take place over 4 months in 5 departments of the Far North region, except Logone et Chari, from 1st October 2024 to 31st January 2026.
